University of Notre Dame

Immerse yourself in the rich history and traditions of Notre Dame. Start by seeing a short film at the Eck Visitor Center, the Spirit of du lac. Then join a free 90 minute walking tour of the campus by student volunteers.

Studebaker National Museum

Cruise through 150 years of history! Follow the arc of the Studebaker Corporation from its modest beginning as a small blacksmith shop to producer of iconic automobiles known worldwide for their breathtaking design. Home to the largest presidential carriage collection in the nation.

The History Museum

Discover the 38-room Oliver Mansion and all of its original furnishings, revealing a rare glimpse into the 1900's.

South Bend Chocolate Company

Let your sense be your guide through the home of the largest collection of chocolate memorabilia in the world. Take tours of the factory and the Inside Scoop Tour to see chocolate treats being made. Don't forget to stop by the factory outlet store to purchase their "mistakes".

Marshall County Historical Museum

Explore a treasury full of exhibits and interactive displays. Located in an old department store with offices above on the 2nd floor, still undisturbed. Each office gives a look into the past. One office is an interactive train layout. Another is the doctor's office. Another is a communication room with old switchboards and radios... you get the drift. One of the best museums in the area and the best part... it's free!

Culver Military Academy

The drive to the academy puts you on the Old Lincoln Highway and then on the infamous Trail of Death. Following the Potawatomi Trail of Death into the country, leads to the only Federal Monument to an American Indian Chief Menominee. Continuing your trip puts you at the Academy, home of the famous Black Horse Troop. They have been present at many Presidential inaugural parades. After touring the school grounds, you might want to drive the east shore of Lake Maxinkuckee. The multi-million dollar homes there are breathtaking.

Antiques

You can visit Warsaw, Plymouth, Bourbon and Pierceton. Maps will direct you to more antiques shops that you can shake a stick at.
